



Submission Guidelines

1. Name and surname of the author(s), title and position, entire name of the research center / institution/company, and email address should be specified at the beginning of the article.

2. Articles' size should be between 20.000 and 50.000 signs (with spaces), including references.

3. Articles should be written in English, French, Spanish or Romanian.

4. Each article should contain an abstract of 1.000-2.000 signs and max. 5 keywords. If the article is written in Romanian, the title, abstract and keywords should be written also in English, French or Spanish.

5. Quoting will be made within the text, and the bibliography will be mentioned at the end of the article, according to this model:
